

About St. Paul's Preschool

St. Paul's offers both a 2-day program and a 3-day program for preschool children. The program is designed to enable the student the opportunity for continued growth, progress, and development. Ultimately, we strive to prepare the child for a smoother transition from preschool to kindergarten.

Two Day Preschool Class

To be eligible for the 2-day class, children must be 3 years of age by August 31st of that year. The 2-day class is limited to 16 students and meets on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9-11:30 am.

Three Day Preschool Class


To be eligible for the 3-day class, children must be 4 years of age by August 31 of that year. This aligns with the Red Lion School District eligibility guidelines (the student must be 5 years old by August 31 to be eligible for kindergarten). The 3-day class is limited to 18 students and meets on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9-11:30 am.

A Typical Day in Preschool:

9:00-9:20: Computer learning, table activities, puzzles, and other hands-on learning.

9:20-9:35: Opening attendance, assign helpers, news, weather, calendar, day of the week. Recite "Pledge of Allegiance" and exercise to music

9:35-10:20: Thematic activities, letters of the alphabet, colors, shapes, and counting, skills such as cutting, pasting, writing/tracing and other kindergarten readiness skills. Instruction will include story relating to the day's theme. Puppets will be used to help introduce letters and sounds. Daily lessons may include math, science, social studies, art, or music.

10:20-11:00: Prayer, snack, and free play time. Our room is full of things to spark the student's imagination! (Dress up, kitchen, train table, art center, and more!)

II:00-II:30: Show and tell, movement activities.

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES:

Throughout the year, students take monthly field trips (except for September and January). Students will also have classroom parties to celebrate and learn about various holidays. Parent volunteers can become involved by helping with parties or attending field trips.

END OF YEAR PROGRAM AND GRADUATION:

At the end of the year, we will celebrate graduation with an end of year program.

CHAPEL TIME:

The 3-day students will participate in Chapel time with the pastor of St. Paul's one time per week.



TEACHERS AND STAFF:

Each class is staffed by one teacher and at least one additional classroom assistant.

The parent/teacher relationship is a very important aspect of our program. Working together will enable St. Paul's staff to provide the best preschool experience for your child. Teachers will communicate information through newsletters, social media, email, and church website.

Teachers will provide a report on your child's progress two times throughout the year.



ST PAUL'S PRESCHOOL

St. Paul's United Methodist Church, 45 First Avenue, Red Lion, is accepting preschool registrations for the 2021-22 school year for all classes. This year, eligible 3-day students may also choose to register for a 5-day program. To reserve your spot, you must return your registration form along with the registration fee. Class sizes are limited and filled on a first come/first serve basis.

2-DAY CLASS:

\$90.00 PER MONTH

To be eligible for the 2-day class, children must be 3 years of age by August 31st of that year.

The 2-day class is limited to a total of 16 students and meets on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9-11:30 am.

3-DAY CLASS:

\$110.00 PER MONTH

To be eligible for the 3-day class, children must be 4 years of age by August 31 of that year. This aligns with the Red Lion School District eligibility guidelines (the student must be 5 years old by August 31 to be eligible for kindergarten).

The 3-day class is limited to 18 students and meets on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9-11:30 am.

5-DAY OPTION:

\$180.00 PER MONTH

The 5 day option is only available for the 4-5 year olds (students who are eligible for the 3-day class). For the 5-day option, the students will attend both the 2-day class and the 3-day class.

The 5 day option is limited to 6 students.
