

# **Volunteer Opportunities for you.....**

**Flower and Bulletin Sponsors for 2024**—The 2024 sign-up register is now in the church office on the desk if you want to reserve a date for the coming year. There are sign-up sheets on the table at the rear of the sanctuary where you can sign up for any of these. Please consider helping out with these portions of our service so that our program is complete. Thank you.
